
Prokeimenon of the Fathers, Tone 4 Znamenny Chant

Reader: The God of gods, the Lord hath spoken, and He hath called the earth from the rising of the sun unto the setting thereof. *Choir:* Alleluia (3x)

Reader: Gather together unto Him his holy ones who have established His covenant upon sacrifices. Choir: Alleluia (3x)
