
Tone 1 - Psalm 32


Reader: The Prokeimenon in the First Tone: Let Thy mercy, O Lord, be upon us according as we have hoped in Thee.

Reader: With chastisement hath the Lord chastened me, but He hath not given me over unto death.


Choir: (repeat entire prokeimenon)

Reader: The Prokeimenon in the Third Tone: O chant unto our God, chant ye; chant unto our King, chant ye.




Reader: Clap your hands, all ye nations; shout unto God with a voice of rejoicing. *Choir:* (*repeat entire prokeimenon*)

Reader: The Prokimenon in the 4th Tone: How magnified are Thy works, O Lord! In wisdom hast Thou made them all.





Tone 5 - Psalm 11


Reader: The Prokimenon in the 5th Tone: Thou, O Lord, shalt keep us and shalt preserve us from this generation and forever more.

Tone 6 - Psalm 27


Reader: The Prokimenon in the 6th Tone: O Lord, save Thy people and bless Thine inheritance.

Tone 7 - Psalm 28


Reader: The Prokimenon in the 7th Tone: The Lord will give strength unto His people; the Lord will bless His people with peace.
